We are pleased to announce the 2020 James Suckling scores for Viñalba.



Viñalba Malbec Gran Reserva 2017

93 points

"Very dense, ripe fruit with lots of blackberries, some cherry liquor and a whiff of violets. Full-bodied, juicy and smooth with fine-grained tannin packed in the middle. "

Viñalba Malbec Reserva 2018

92 points

"Some ripe blackberries and plums, as well as tar and smoke undertones. Juicy on the palate with a slightly chewy structure. Full body. Long, warming finish."

Viñalba Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 2018

91 points

"Rich, deep black fruit here. Lots of polished cassis, mixed with black-spice and cigar-box notes. Dense and concentrated at the entry with a firm, muscular backbone."

Viñalba Malbec/Cabernet Franc Reserva 2018

91 points

"Fresh, vibrant black cherries with roasted Mediterranean spices. Very full with ripe tannin that is swathed in fresh fruit, forging a smooth, fleshy mouth feel."

James Suckling visited Argentina back in February to conduct his annual tasting report and the results were published April 2, 2020 after he and his team tasted through more than 1,500 wines.
