The Pierre Rougon signature has grown to guarantee quality and character.



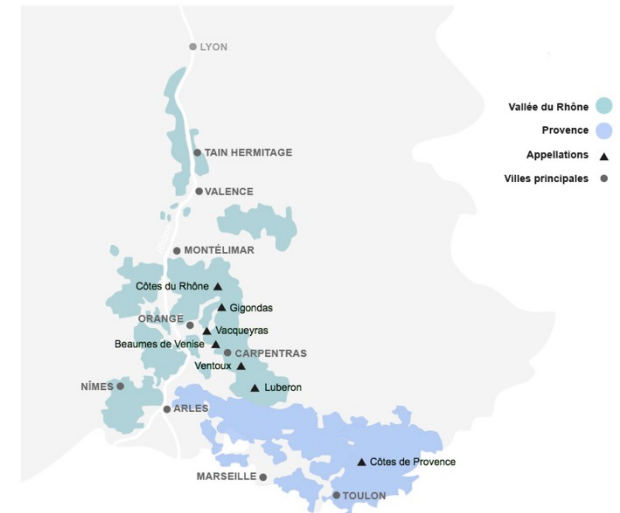
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## Our vineyards

The vines grow on the highest plateaus of Beaumes de Venise, on narrow and sunny terraces, at an altitude between 150m and 330m, against the wonderful backdrop of the Dentelles de Montmirail mountains.

The grapes are meticulously sorted and harvested by hand. The wines of the vineyard testify to their commitment and their great respect for tradition.

The climate is favourable due to the mistral and the intense sunshine of the Côtes du Rhône region - it allows the emblematic grape varieties of the appellations to fully express themselves.

**Winemaking**

Hand harvested from the most beautiful parcels of the vineyard. Alcoholic fermentation in concrete tanks with several pump-overs at the beginning, then soft extractions at the end of fermentation. Maceration for 3-4 week then clarification when the aromas and tannins are balanced. 6 months aging in concrete tanks before bottling.

**Tasting note**

Fine and elegant, this vintage from the Rhône Valley has wonderful dark fruit aromas and is characterized by a long, silky and supple mouth.

**Winemaking**

Manual and mechanical harvest. Grapes fermented together for 4 weeks. Regular pigeage and pumping over during fermentation which takes place in stainless steel tanks.

**Tasting note**

Deep ruby red color. Expressive red fruit and spice on the nose. Round and generous, yet balanced body with a long finish.

**Winemaking**

The grapes were hand harvested, followed by traditional fermentation at 25C, followed by a long maceration period. The wine is aged in French oak foudre.

**Tasting note**

Aromas of herbs de Provence, saddle leather and spiced red and black fruit. Beautifully textured, this medium-bodied Châteauneuf du Pape delivers a juicy, focused and balanced feel through the finish.
