

# Fabre Montmayou - Descorchados 2024

As we continue to be sent the latest scores from Descorchados 2024, we are pleased to share with you some great results from our friends at Fabre Montmayou.



Fabre Montmayou Grand Vin 2020

96 points, MEJOR VISTALBA

“This is a classic malbec-based red wine that has the density of wines made to age well. 2020 was warm throughout Mendoza, and that underscores the voluptuousness of the fruit here, but the tannin structure is firm and solid, which helps support the weight of those ripe flavors and provides balance. All in all, this is a wine for the cellar. When Fabre Montmayou began making his Grand Vin, in 1993, they selected the oldest vines on the property, planted in 1908. The proportion is 85% malbec, 10% cabernet sauvignon, and the rest is merlot, all planted in Vistalba, one of the highest areas in the Luján de Cuyo DO, reaching the Mendoza River.”

Fabre Montmayou Gran Reserva Malbec 2021

“For Gran Reserva, the old vineyards established more than 100 years ago at a property they have in Vistalba, beside the Mendoza River. With a relatively early harvest in late March and a rather cool year, this wine is juicy and refreshing, with a lot of tart red fruits in a dense and powerful body, with firm tannins and long flavors. A big wine that deserves to be cellared for at least five years.”

Fabre Montmayou Reserva Malbec 2022

‘This is from a selection of their own vineyards, about 40 years old, in the Vistalba area, on the banks of the Mendoza River. About 200,000 bottles of this wine were produced, and it’s a delight of ripe black-fruit flavors and a soft and creamy texture. A typical malbec, very much of this zone, with that succulence and fruity generosity.’

Fabre Montmayou Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon 2022

90 points

‘Coming from vineyards in Perdriel, in the Luján de Cuyo DOC, this is a juicy cabernet full of ripe red fruits with a bit of herbs and menthol. The palate offers enough tannins for roasted meats, and the herbal finish provides freshness.’
