



New 2024 Vinous scores for Casa Gran del Siurana

Casa Gran del Siurana has once again been recognized by the influential international publication Vinous, standing out for its quality and excellence.

The wines were tasted and scored by journalist and wine critic; Joaquin Hidalgo, following on from a recent visit to Spain. The full results can be seen in the Vinous online reports, titled "The Rambunctious Catalan Mediterranean and Beyond" and "From Revolution to Evolution: The Garnatxas and Cariñenas of Priorat & Montsant."

These results not only highlight the quality of these wineries but also reinforce Joaquín Hidalgo's observations in his analysis of Priorat: "Priorat has one unique characteristic: consistent soils. Whether it's the black Llicorellas of Bellunt del Priorat or the browner ones of Poboleda". This unique character of the region, where wines reflect their origins in a singular way, finds in Garnatxa and Cariñena two leading varieties that contribute depth, complexity, and a distinctive profile. As Hidalgo notes: "Where Garnatxa reflects an infusion of flowers and red fruit with some classical structure, Cariñena yields a more compact palate with delicious notes of pomegranate and a distinctly silky feel".
