BACKGROUND

Another great wine from the Pierre Rougon portfolio, the vineyards for this wine are located on the foothills of the Luberon. The vines produce an elegant, balanced and delightful fruity wine, worthy of the greatest wine of the Luberon appellation.

WINEMAKING

The fruit is picked at optimal ripeness to ensure a fresh and natural style. After de-stalking, a short skin contact maceration extracts the fleshiness of this wine followed by fermentation at low temperature. The blend is bottled very early to preserve the delicate and "crunchy" freshness of the fruit.

TASTING NOTE

An elegant and clear pink color with a delicious nose of fresh, ripe fruits, followed by a deep and long finish.
