This wine comes from a range of high altitude vineyards, from those unique sites that captivates and inspires Karim to capture their essence. Concrete Tank was born as a tribute to our winemaking philosophy since our beginnings in 1998, which has revolved around the beautiful and functional concrete tanks of our centenary winery located in La Consulta, being pioneers in the rescue of our Argentinean winemaking heritage.
