BACKGROUND

Alandes represents our intention to create wines from grapes sourced from diverse regions along the Andes Mountains. A Cabernet Franc from a dry continental climate and high altitude vineyards. Unique and classic expression from this traditional cépage, combining great character and finesse.

WINEMAKING

Fermented in small concrete vats. Aged for 18 months in French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTE

The nose of red fruit, raspberry and pyrazine sets the tone for a concentrated red wine with moderate freshness marshalled by firm tannins. Mentholated at the back of the mouth, with a pleasant aftertaste.
