BACKGROUND

This wine is an unusual collaboration between two leading winemakers. Touriga Nacional is the flagship grape of Portugal, and the Touriga for this wine was made in Argentina by Portuguese Winemaker Rui Reguingua. The Malbec was made by Viñalba's winemaker Hervé J. Fabre. Vegan certified.

WINEMAKING

Bunch selection. Cold maceration during 4 days at 10°C (50°F). Selected yeasts. Delestages and pump-overs three times a day. Extended maceration for 25 days at 28°C (82°F). Malolactic fermentation occurred in stainless steel tanks. 60% of the wine was aged for 12 months in second use French oak barrels of 225 and 400 litres.

TASTING NOTE

Dark red with violet shiny tones. An unusual blend for Argentina combining 2 extraordinary varietals. Well balanced with a great structure, so tannins and nicely integrated oak. The nose is elegant with floral aromas of violet and roses and red dark berries.
