BACKGROUND

Fruit for this New Zealand Rosé is sourced from a range of premium, sustainably certified vineyards across the iconic Hawke's Bay and Marlborough regions.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were picked, crushed and pressed with minimum skin contact. The juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks at various temperatures to capture the fresh flavors

TASTING NOTE

A pretty and refreshing rosé, crisp, fragrant, and medium-dry in style. Raspberry and strawberry aromas with a touch of persimmon.

Raspberry opens up to peach and rock melon with strawberry conserve and pear. Mineral notes and fennel noted on finish. Fresh and zesty.
