## Our vineyards

The Pendee Farm Vineyard in the Eden Valley was planted in the 1960's, just a few kilometres away from the famous Stonegarden Vineyard in Springton, Eden Valley. This site was selected for its incredible soils, its distinct sub-climate, and for its ability to produce truly unique varietal wines that are truly reflective of the region.

Nestled on the western side of South Australia's renowned Barossa Valley, Stonewell Vineyard spans 75 acres of meticulously tended vines, producing premium red varietals such as Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Tempranillo, and Grenache. With a reputation for quality, the vineyard supplies exceptional fruit to celebrated Barossa winemakers. These partnerships bring out the best in the vineyard's offerings, with each vintage expressing the remarkable terroir and distinctive profile of Stonewell fruit.
