Our story

When Miguel Mateu acquired the Castle of Perelada in 1923, one of his hopes was to revive a wine-making tradition that traces its genesis back to the fourteenth century, when the Carmelite monks produced wine for the whole region. More than eighty years later, Castillo Perelada has become one of the leading wine producers in Spain and has led the Empordà, the oldest wine-producing region in Spain, in its spectacular revival.

Perelada has 131 ha divided into 5 characteristic vineyards and the company is now owned by Miguel's grandson; Javier Suqué Mateu.

When he took over the management of our family's winery at the end of the eighties, it was his dream to produce wines of an extremely high quality. He wanted to show that the climate and terroir of the Empordà were capable of producing fine, well-structured wines with a clearly defined personality.



Our Vineyards

The Empordà is a small area where there is a variety of soils found in few other places in the world.

Lands that have borne witness to how different civilizations cultivated the art of wine.

The heterogeneity of the land on which the vines grow allows Perelada to obtain grapes with a wide range of nuances.

5 vineyards:

- Pont de Molins: sandy and light soils containing some silt.
- Malaveïna: red clay with large rocks.
- La Garriga: acid, sandy and gravelly soils.
- Garbet: slate.
- Espolla: Slate & acidic soil.



Our Winery

We are in the process of building a new Castell de Perelada winery, still which will be the first in Europe to have the LEED® BD + C environmental and energy certification, developed by the US Green Building Council, that will certify the sustainability and high efficiency of its design and construction.

The new facilities will have the capacity to handle 2,700,000 kg of grapes and to produce about 1,900,000 litres of wine and 2,240,000 bottles. At the same time as the production, the focus will be on the sharing of wine culture and sales of the product, turning the winery into an iconic wine tourism destination providing tastings, tours and other attractions.
